

Filter replacement:

If you own a Green and Black HomeBiogas system that looks like this illustration, follow these steps for replacing the gas filter:

Remove the old filter:

1

Use or release the gas from the system until the gas tank is empty.

2

Remove the Gas Outlet & Fertilizer Outlet Cap. Avoid breathing close to the opened outlet.

3

(A) Wear protective gloves and remove the rubber sealing ring from the Gas Outlet.
(B) Remove the filter using the string attached to the filter's cap.

Install the new filter:

1

Remove both cover stickers from the base and cap of the new filter.

2

Wear protective gloves and install the rubber seal from the old filter into the new filter. Make sure it is pushed all the way up.

3

Insert the new filter into the Gas Outlet pipe. Push the filter down firmly to ensure a good seal.

4

Place the sealing ring back into its slot in the Gas Outlet pipe.
